West Indian American Association of Greater Bridgeport (WIAAGB) 2020 Scholarship

Policy

- 1. The West Indian American Association of Greater Bridgeport (WIAAGB) awards one \$1,500 academic scholarship and five \$1,000 book scholarships to deserving students of English speaking West Indian heritage in the Greater Bridgeport area¹. The Association reserves the right to review all applications and award the scholarships based on its own guidelines.
- 2. Completed applications must be post marked no later than Saturday, May 9th 2020. The information disclosed in the application will determine a student's eligibility to be awarded a scholarship. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 3. Each successful applicant will be awarded a **one-time** only scholarship, and is not eligible to re-apply.
- 4. The WIAAGB Education Committee will determine who will receive the scholarships and will notify successful students by Wednesday May 27th 2020. Awardees must notify the Association of their acceptance by Wednesday June 3rd 2020, via email.
- 5. If the deadline passes without an acknowledgment, the scholarship will be withdrawn and the student will be notified by letter.
- 6. Checks will be presented by the Association at an Awards Reception scheduled for June 13th 2020, at a venue to be announced. Awardees or designated parent/guardian must be present at the Awards Ceremony to accept the scholarship, or it will be forfeited.
- 7. Scholarship recipients and their parents/guardians will be invited to attend the WIAAGB Scholarship Banquet on Saturday September 26th 2020, where recipients will be recognized with the inclusion of their photographs and biographies in the Association's journal. Scholarship recipients will receive a free ticket to the banquet.
- 8. Scholarship recipients will be invited to attend the following year's Scholarship Award Ceremony.

Guidelines

- 1. **Applicant must either have been born in the English-speaking West Indies**² or have at least one parent or grandparent who was born in one of the countries listed below.
- 2. Applicant must excel academically, exhibit leadership potential, participate in extra-curricular activities and be involved in community service.
- 3. Applicant must maintain a minimum 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA).
- 4. Applicant applying for this scholarship must be graduating from high school in May or June 2020 and plan to enter college as a full-time matriculated student in September 2020.

Required Documentation:

- A. Official High School Academic transcript signed and sealed by school official.
- **B. SAT or ACT Test Scores**
- C. Proof of acceptance to a college accredited by one of the six Regional Accrediting Commissions of Higher Education associated with the American Council on Education.
- D. A short essay of at least 350 words explaining what qualifies you for this scholarship and why you feel it should be awarded to you.
- E. Two letters of recommendation addressing student's involvement in extracurricular school activities and community service. Letters cannot be from family or friends).
- F. Signed Photo Video Release Form and Photo for inclusion in the WIAAGB Scholarship booklet. (Parent's signature is required on page 5 for students under age 18). Photos will be published only if student is awarded a scholarship.

Failure to provide all required document will disqualify an applicant.
